Bronica (Drohobycz), Galizien, Austria; later Bronica (Drohobycz), Lwow, Poland; now Bronytsia, Drohobych, L'viv, Ukraine

Bruchowica (Podbuż), Galizien, Austria. It appears that this historic locality has been incorporated into Rybnyk, Drohobych, L'viv, Ukraine

Bykow (Łaka), Galizien, Austria; later Bykow (Sambor), Lwow, Poland; now Bykiv, Drohobych, L'viv, Ukraine. Filmed with records from other villages

Bystrzyca (Podbuż), Galizien, Austria; later Bystrzyca (Drohobycz), Lwow, Poland; now Bystrytsia, Drohobych, L'viv, Ukraine

Delawa (Drohobycz), Galizien, Austria; later Delawa (Drohobycz), Lwow, Poland; now Daliava, Drohobych, L'viv, Ukraine

Dereżyce (Drohobycz), Galizien, Austria; later Dereżyce (Drohobycz), Lwow, Poland; now Derezhyci, Drohobych, L'viv, Ukraine

Dobrohostow (Drohobycz), Galizien, Austria; later Dobrohostow (Drohobycz), Lwow, Poland; now Dobrohostiv, Drohobych, L'viv, Ukraine

Dobrowlany (Medenice), Galizien, Austria; later Dobrowlany (Medenice), Lwow, Poland; now Dobrivliany, Drohobych, L'viv, Ukraine

Dołhe Medenickie (Medenice), Galizien, Austria; later Dołhe Medenickie (Drohobycz), Lwow, Poland; now Dovhe (near Opary), Drohobych, L'viv, Ukraine

Dołhe Podbuskie (Podbuż), Galizien, Austria; later Dołhe Podbuskie (Drohobycz), Lwow, Poland; now Dovhe (along the Stryj River), Drohobych, L'viv, Ukraine

Dorożow (Łaka), Galizien, Austria; later Dorożow (Sambor), Lwow, Poland; now Verkhnyi Dorozhiv, Drohobych, L'viv, Ukraine

Gaje Niżne (Drohobycz), Galizien, Austria; later Gaje Niżne (Drohobycz), Lwow, Poland; now Nyzhni Hai;, Drohobych, L'viv, Ukraine

Gaje Wyżne (Drohobycz), Galizien, Austria; later Gaje Wyżne (Drohobycz), Lwow, Poland; now Verkhni Hai;, Drohobych, L'viv, Ukraine

Hubicze (Drohobycz), Galizien, Austria; later Hubicze (Drohobycz), Lwow, Poland; now

Hubychi, Drohobych, L'viv, Ukraine

Jasienica Solna (Drohobych), Galizien, Austria; later Jasienica Solna (Drohobych), Lwow, Poland; now ІAsenytia-Sil'na, Drohobych, L'viv, Ukraine. Records from neighboring localities have been included in the same file and filmed in the same item with records listed here

Josefsberg, (Korośnica), Lwow, Poland; now Korosnytsya, L'viv, Ukraine; formerly in Galicia. Includes Ugartsberg, Letnia, etc

Kołpiec (Drohobycz), Galizien, Austria; later Kołpiec (Drohobycz), Lwow, Poland. From modern-day maps it appears that this historic locality has been incorporated into Stebnyk, Drohobych, L'viv, Ukraine

Konigsau, Galizien, Austria; later Rowne (Drohobycz), Lwow, Poland; now Rivne, Drohobych, L'viv, Ukraine

Łokiec (Podbuż), Galizien, Austria. It appears that this historic locality was probably incorporated into Rybnyk, Drohobych, L'viv, Ukraine

Majdan (Podbuż), Galizien, Austria; later Majdan (Drohobycz), Lwow, Poland; now Maŭdan, Drohobych, L'viv, Ukraine. Filmed with records from other villages

Medenice, Galizien, Austria; later Medenice (Drohobycz), Lwow, Poland; now Medenitsia, Drohobych, L'viv, Ukraine

Mraźnica (Drohobycz), Galizien, Austria; later Mraźnica (Drohobycz), Lwow, Poland; now Mraznytsi, Drohobych, L'viv, Ukraine. Filmed with records from other villages

Nawarya, Galicia, Austria; later Nawarja (Lwow), Lwow, Poland; now Navariya, L'viv, Ukraine. Includes Glinna (now became part of Navariia), Mostki, Malinowka, Polanka, Pustomyty, Wolica. Later Pustomyty became a separate parish

Nowoszyce (Łaka), Galizien, Austria; later Nowoszyce (Sambor), Lwow, Poland; now Novoshychi, Drohobych, L'viv, Ukraine

Opary (Medenice), Galizien, Austria; later Opary (Drohobycz), Lwow, Poland; now Opary, Drohobych, L'viv, Ukraine

Ortynice (Łaka), Galizien, Austria; later Ortynice (Sambor), Lwow, Poland; now Ortynychi, Drohobych, L'viv, Ukraine. Filmed with records from other villages

Pereproxyna (Podbuż), Galizien, Austria; later Pereproxynie (Drohobycz), Lwow, Poland; now Pereproxyn', Drohobych, L'viv, Ukraine. Filmed with records from other villages

Popiele (Drohobycz), Galizien, Austria; later Popiele (Drohobycz), Lwow, Poland; now Popeli, Drohobych, L'viv, Ukraine

Prusy (Łaka), Galizien, Austria; later Prusy (Sambor), Lwow, Poland; now Bystrytsia (near Novoshychi; known as Prusy until 1946), Drohobych, L'viv, Ukraine

Rabczyce (Medenice), Galizien, Austria; later Rabczyce (Drohobycz), Lwow, Poland; now Ripchytci, Drohobych, L'viv, Ukraine

Raniowice (Drohobycz), Galizien, Austria; later Raniowice (Drohobycz), Lwow, Poland; now Ranevychi, Drohobych, L'viv, Ukraine. Filmed with records from other villages

Rybnik (Podbuż), Galizien, Austria; later Rybnik (Drohobycz), Lwow, Poland; now Rybnyk, Drohobych, L'viv, Ukraine

Rychcice, Galizien, Austria; later Rychcice, Lwow, Poland; now Rykhtychi, L'viv, Ukraine. Includes Dobrowlany now Dobrivlyany; and Słońsko, now Solons'ke

Smolna (Podbuż), Galizien, Austria; later Smolna (Drohobycz), Lwow, Poland; now Smil'na, Drohobych, L'viv, Ukraine

Śniatynka (Drohobycz), Galizien, Austria; later Śniatynka (Drohobycz), Lwow, Poland; now Sniatynka, Drohobych, L'viv, Ukraine

Stanyła (Drohobycz), Galizien, Austria; later Staniła (Drohobycz), Lwow, Poland; now Stanya, Drohobych, L'viv, Ukraine

Stara Wieś (Drohobycz), Galizien, Austria; later Stara Wieś (Drohobycz), Lwow, Poland; now Stare Selo, Drohobych, L'viv, Ukraine

Stebnik (Drohobycz), Galizien, Austria; later Stebnik (Drohobycz), Lwow, Poland; now Stebnyk, Drohobych, L'viv, Ukraine

Ułyczno (Drohobycz), Galizien, Austria; later Uliczno (Drohobycz), Lwow, Poland; now Ulychne, Drohobych, L'viv, Ukraine

Wacowice (Drohobycz), Lwow, Poland; now Zaluzhany (Drohobych), L'viv, Ukraine; formerly in Galicia

Wacowice (Drohobycz), Galizien, Austria; later Wacowice (Drohobycz), Lwow, Poland; now appears to have been incorporated into Zaluzhany, Drohobych, L'viv, Ukraine

Winniki (Podbuż), Galizien, Austria; later Winniki (Drohobycz), Lwow, Poland; now Vynnyky, Drohobych, L'viv, Ukraine

Wołoszcza (Łaka), Galizien, Austria; later Wołoszcza (Sambor), Lwow, Poland; now Voloshcha, Drohobych, L'viv, Ukraine

Wroblowice (Medenice), Galizien, Austria; later Wroblewice (Drohobycz), Lwow, Poland; now Voroblevychi, Drohobych, L'viv, Ukraine

Zaricze (Stary Sambor), Galizien, Austria. It appears that this historic locality was probably incorporated into Novyi Kropyvnyk, Drohobych, L'viv, Ukraine. Filmed with records from other villages

Załokieć (Podbuż), Galizien, Austria; later Załokieć (Drohobycz), Lwow, Poland; now Zalokot', Drohobych, L'viv, Ukraine

Zdzianna (Podbuż), Galizien, Austria; later Zdzianna (Drohobycz), Lwow, Poland; now Zhdanivka, Drohobych, L'viv, Ukraine
